Items are repaired and reused where possible, and given to low income households, community groups and

charities, or recycled.

TerraCycle is an innovative recycling company that recycles typically hard-to-recycle waste, by partnering with various manufacturers. It offers a range of free recycling schemes which enable individuals and groups to collect waste for recycling, send it off to Terracycle and raise funds for charity depending on how much is collected.

Co-op Soft-plastic-packaging Scheme

Recycled by Co-op at their Co-op Martingate store and at Corsham Recycling Hub.

All Co-op own-brand food packaging can be recycled.

While we will accept soft plastics from any retailer or brand, we cannot guarantee that such third-party packaging will be recycled. Some of the more technical materials will have multiple layers, the composition of which we cannot be certain of, and these may end up being incinerated to produce energy. However, the majority of third-party soft plastic will be made from materials which will go to be recycled within our scheme.

Please note that the labelling on packaging may not be up to date with the soft-plastics recycling scheme. As such, not all soft plastics will currently be labelled as recyclable. We are working hard in this space to ensure that labelling is clear, and hope to bring an updated label early next year.

Clean it

First, rinse your packaging out.

Pop it into our softplastics recycling unit at a Co-op near you or drop it off to Corsham Recycling Hub and we'll pass it on.

Composting

Nature's way of recycling

Amazingly, up to 50% of the rubbish we throw away can be composted. Setting up a compost bin can be really easy and inexpensive - obtain free wooden pallets from local Facebook groups, screw/nail together and off you go.

Aim for a 50/50 mix of green and brown materials, and turn occasionally. Even if you don't want the compost, you're keeping waste from going to landfill and the level will keep composting down so you can keep adding to it.

Or, buy a discounted Green Johanna food waste compost bin for £50 from Wiltshire Council and compost ALL cooked and uncooked food waste including meat, fish, bones, dairy products, vegetables and fruit, as well as garden waste.

What to add

Greens

- Tea bags
- Grass cuttings
- Vegetable peelings, salad leaves and fruit scraps
- Old flowers and nettles
- Coffee grounds and filter papers
- Spent bedding plants
- Rhubarb leaves
- Young, annual weeds eg Chickweed

Browns

- Crushed egg shells
- Egg and cereal boxes
- Corrugated cardboard and newspaper (scrunched up)
- Toilet and kitchen roll tubes
- Garden prunings
- Dry leaves, twigs and hedge clippings
- Straw and hay
- Bedding from vegetarian pets
- Ashes from wood, paper and lumpwood charcoal
- Sawdust and wood clippings
- Wool
- Woody clippings
- Cotton threads and string (made from natural fibre)
- Feathers
- Vacuum bag contents

- Old natural fibre clothes (cut into small pieces)
- Tissues, paper towels and napkins
- Shredded confidential documents
- Corn cobs and stalks

Also add packaging which has the home-composting logo on it, eg some coffee pods, and Co-op carrier bags, which are now all home-compostable and can be used as liners in your kitchen-waste bin.

What not to add

- Diseased plants
- Perennial weeds
- Cooked food
- Citrus (worms don't like it)
- Raw meat
- Dairy products
- Gloss or heavily-coloured paper
- Ash from coal fires
- Cat/dog waste
- Autumn leaves (best used to make leaf mould)

Local peat-free compost

If you need to top-up, or prefer to buy compost, then look for PEAT FREE compost.

Available locally at:

- Corsham Hardware
- Co-op (Martingate)
- Lowden Garden Centre
- Whitehall Garden Centre

If you are looking to buy locally-produced compost then it is worth contacting Hills Waste, who compost all of the garden waste from our green bins. You can buy in bulk or 30 litre bags, and they will also deliver.
